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PROFILE

I graduated from the Faculty of Arts, Mansoura University, Department of **History** in 1987, and graduated from the same faculty from **Classic** Department in 1996. I joined the postgraduate studies in the Department of History (**Medieval History**) at the same college and university in 1989 and obtained a **master's degree** in 1996 on a topic about one of the Turkish pastoral peoples (**Pechenegs**) in the Western Steppes and Eastern Europe. I completed, in my **Doctorate**, a study of the influence of Turkish pastoral peoples in Eastern and Central Europe by studying the **Kingdom of Hungary in the Middle Ages** and obtained a doctorate degree in 2004 with a grade of first honors. I joined the Faculty of Arts, University of Taiz, Republic of Yemen in the academic year 2005-2006, In 2008, I Joined the Faculty of Education, Damanhur University, as a teacher of Medieval History. In 2014, I got the position of **Assistant Professor of Medieval History**. In 2022, I obtained the position of **Professor of Medieval History**, I am **now** rewriting and revising my master's and Doctoral dissertations in the light of recent studies.
